- + Discover the peaceful monastic site founded by St Kevin, featuring Ireland's best-preserved Round Tower, a medieval cathedral, and St Kevin's Kitchen.

- + Enjoy an evening of authentic Irish food, music, and culture to celebrate the journey through Ireland.
- Visit Solas Bhride Centre, St Brigid's Cathedral, and her sacred well, immersing in the legacy of Ireland's beloved female saint.
- + Attend the Women of Faith, Women of Strength conference at the Pontifical Gregorian University.

Hinerary

DAY 1: SUNDAY 08 JUNE 2025 - DEPART FOR IRELAND

DAY 2: MONDAY 09 JUNE - ARRIVE DUBLIN

Cead Mile Failte – Welcome to Ireland! On arrival in Dublin, we will be met by our Irish guide and transferred by coach to our hotel for check-in.

DAY 3: TUESDAY 10 JUNE - DUBLIN

Proposed Mass – Morning Mass close to the Hotel

Our morning sightseeing tour will include statue-lined O'Connell Street as we drive around and view some of the city's elegant Georgian Squares. Visit the Trinity College Library, home of the famous 8th century Book of Kells and onwards to St Patrick's Cathedral, Ireland's largest Cathedral made famous by its former dean Jonathan Swift, author of 'Gulliver's Travels'.

We continue our drive past Dublin Post Office and on to St Mary's Pro Cathedral. The original, partially completed facade was replaced by the present imposing neo-Romanesque structure by Sir Thomas Dean in 1868.

In the afternoon we visit Coolock House. *Dublin overnight (BD)*

DAY 4: WEDNESDAY 11 JUNE - DUBLIN

Proposed Mass - Mercy Convent

After breakfast we visit the Mercy Convent in Baggot Street, the first house of Mother Catherine McAuley, founder of the Sisters of Mercy. This is where the determined Mary MacKillop met with the inflexible Bishop Quinn of Bathurst on Oct 10, 1874 who wanted the Sisters kept under his diocesan control (visit under own arrangements).

This afternoon, visit the Presentation Sisters. We also visit the Crypt at St Theresa's Church where the first thirteen Sisters of Mercy are buried.

DAY 5: THURSDAY 12 JUNE - GLENDALOUGH DAY

This morning, we depart for the holy town of Glendalough - Valley of the two lakes'. This renowned place of pilgrimage is the site of the monastic settlement founded in the 6th century by St Kevin - a man of noble stock. Coming here to be alone as an ascetic contemplative monk, his prayerful inspiration ironically attracted many others and thus the community of Glendalough springs from a hermitage. From a simple beginning, the site grew to become famous as a centre of learning throughout Europe. Standing for 600 years, it was destroyed in 1398. Our visit here in Glendalough is focused on the remains at both the upper and the lower lakes in the valley. The upper site is simpler and more in fitting with his

life as a hermit, whereas the lower one has

the more famous monastic monuments

- one of Ireland's best preserved Round

kitchen and the diminutive Priest House

Towers, a roofless Cathedral, St Kevin's

over the Saint's tomb-shrine

On the way back this afternoon we will stop in Maynooth, where we will visit with representatives from the National Board for Safeguarding Children in the Catholic Church at St Patrick's College. We then continue on for a visit to the Association of Missionaries & Religious of Ireland (AMRI).
